



### **Coleman-USASBE Scholarships for New Conference Attendees:**

Scholarships for conference fees are available for educators in the United States who previously have not been a member of USASBE. This year there are several categories of scholarships:

**Coleman-USASBE Cross Campus Challenge Scholarships** are intended to foster collaborative and cross-disciplinary efforts from across our campuses. Educators with an interest in entrepreneurship from all disciplines are encouraged to apply for the scholarship.

**Coleman-USASBE Small School Scholarships** are for educators from schools with less than 4,500 students. USASBE has a wealth of resources, including most importantly its members, which offer leverage to the limited resources that most small schools have.

**USASBE Doctoral Candidate Scholarships** are available to students pursuing their doctoral degree with an active interest any of the many dimensions of entrepreneurship. The scholarship is an excellent way to meet other students pursuing a career in entrepreneurship education as well as some the leading educators in the field.

### **Coleman-USASBE Scholarships for Returning Conference Attendees:**

**2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Year Coleman Scholarship** applications are invited for members who received scholarships in 2005 and 2006.

Applicants submit a one-page statement (from the registration page) of how you intend to influence entrepreneurship education and how you will benefit from the conference and membership in USASBE.

You will be notified about the status of your application as soon as possible upon receipt of your registration payment.

At the conclusion of the conference scholarship recipients will be eligible for reimbursement for the registration fees. Please note that the USASBE membership fee is not included in the scholarship.

Finally, there are a limited number of scholarships in each category and they will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis for those who meet the requirements, have paid the registration fee and are approved.
