To submit your syllabi for possible inclusion in the USASBE Syllabus Exchange, please send it as an attachment via email to Dr. Ethné Swartz at swartz@fdu.edu. In your email please be sure to specify the teaching level (Graduate/Undergraduate) of the course and also provide a brief summary (approx. 100 words) of the syllabus/course. Before submitting your syllabus, please ensure that it conforms to the inclusion criteria outlined below:

Criteria for inclusion of syllabi:

- Syllabi should address relevant issues in entrepreneurship teaching.
- The manuscript should contain content that can be used by other entrepreneurship faculty to form the basis of expanding current practice in the classroom.
- Content and subject areas should be timely and contain relevant content.
- Acceptable adherence to basic grammar, spelling rules, and contain complete references for all citations.
- Should be the authors' original work.
- All syllabi should be in MS-Word or RTF format (not PDF or other formats, please).
- Include contact information for all authors.
- Should (ideally) be in compliance with best practice for syllabus construction in terms of AACSB guidelines.
- All syllabi should list the following statement by the author(s) on the last page:

The author(s) of this syllabus provides USASBE with permission to post the document to its Syllabus Exchange. Visitors to the Syllabus Exchange may download and use this syllabus for the purposes of learning and teaching. The syllabus does not contain any libelous statements, nor does it infringe anyone's copyright, proprietary or statutory rights.
